

WHAT IS MOTTEP?

The Minority Organ Tissue Transplant Education Program (MOTTEP), founded by Dr. Clive O. Callender in 1993, is the first national organization dedicated to educating and empowering multicultural communities with the facts about organ and tissue donation and the power to save lives. Since 1993, MOTTEP has been on a mission to address the urgent need for minority donors, reducing the transplant waiting list and transforming lives through education and prevention.

Detroit MOTTEP, launched in 1995 in partnership with Gift of Life Michigan, and has proudly served our community for 30 years. During this time, we have grown to be a trusted voice for organ and tissue donation in multicultural communities, as well as championing health and fostering connections that bridge cultures. Our impact is clear—thanks to dedicated outreach, donation rates have risen from 10.8% to an inspiring 40%. Together, we are building a legacy of hope, health, healing, and unity across our communities.

OUR GOALS

Establish cooperative relationships and/or acquire sponsorship from public and private organizations to assist in the educational campaigns for multicultural populations within the community. **Empower** specific ethnic multicultural populations to develop and implement Action Plans that will increase awareness levels within their own communities.

Educate ethnic multicultural populations on facts regarding organ/tissue donation and transplantation and about the specific behaviors and the resulting decreases that lead to the need for organ/tissue transplantation, e.g., Diabetes, Hypertension, Heart Disease, Obesity, Substance Abuse, and increase the number organ/tissue donor registries signed by minorities.


